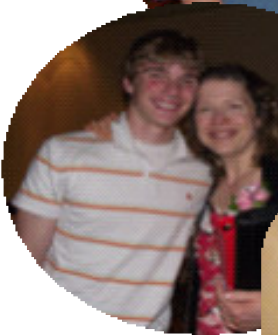

Energy - Gavilon operates a physical storage, transportation and logistics network, purchasing crude oil, refined products, natural gas, natural gas liquids and renewable fuels from producers, and selling and distributing these products to refineries, industrial companies, power producers, local distribution companies and other wholesale markets.
